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# **How to Make Toothpaste Slime**

craft-based lesson plan for parents and teachers



- Gel-based toothpaste
- School glue
- Sugar
- Food coloring (optional)
- Glitter (optional)



## WHAT TO DO:

- 1. Squeeze a glob of toothpaste next to a glob of glue on a paper plate.
- 2. Begin mixing the glue into the toothpaste a little bit at a time until it's all mixed together and it becomes a little slimy.
- Add a little bit of sugar to the mixture.
   This will help the slime become more solid.
   The slime should stick to your spoon without falling off easily.
- 4. Add in food coloring and/or glitter and mix until you like the way it looks.
- 5. Play with your new slime!



## WHAT TO TALK ABOUT:

### When was toothpaste invented?

Did you know the kind of toothpastes we use today weren't invented until the 1850s? Before that, toothpaste was actually more like a powder. Can you imagine brushing your teeth with powder?

### How can you keep your pearly whites bright?

Brushing 2 times each day with fluoride toothpaste is very important for good oral health. Brushing stops cavities from forming because it wipes away all the food and bacteria from your mouth.

### Need more conversation starters?

Use the following questions to get kids talking about their oral health habits: Do you brush your teeth morning and night? What color is your toothbrush? What is your favorite kind of toothpaste to use?
