A shark can lose 30,000 teeth in its lifetime.



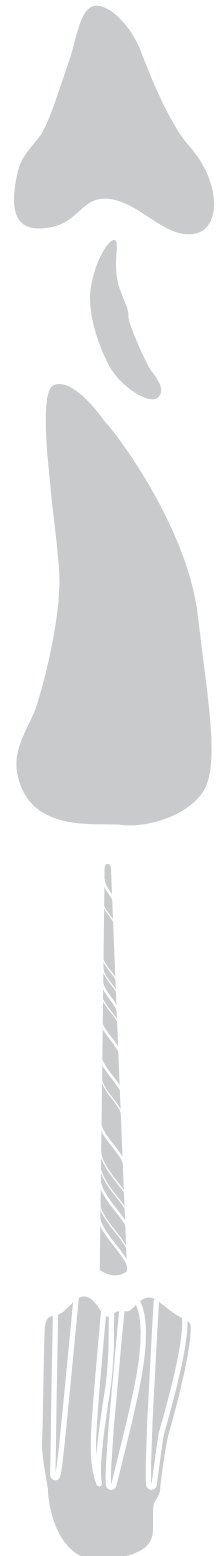
The “horn” on top of a narwhal’s head is really a big tooth.
